

PUBLIC NOTICE

Our cleanliness drives and beautification efforts are usually marred by unauthorized posters/banners/ hoardings etc. Government of NCT of Delhi have already started the strict enforcement of the provisions of 'The Delhi Prevention of Defacement of Property Act, 2017' and have also requested DCB to implement sub clause (xi) clause (1) of section 289 of The Cantonments Act, 2006, which deals with the subject. In this regard a weekly report is required to be sent to the Government regarding action taken against those who deface public property/ premises .

Through this public notice an appeal is being made to one and all to participate with us in this drive to keep our area clean and abandon the illegal practice of affixing posters/ banners/ hoardings upon any building, monument, wall, fence, tree or any other public place/property. It is further intimated that any violations of the provisions of Section 289 (1) (a) (xi) of The Cantonments Act, 2006 shall be punishable with a fine which may extend to Rupees two thousand five hundred, however, repeated offences shall invite higher penalty.
