GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The written test will be held on 24/03/2017 from 1000 hrs to 1200 hrs for the post of General Duty Medical Officer (GDMO).**
2. The written examination shall consist of 20 descriptive questions/case studies pertaining to Anatomy, Physiology, Pharmacology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Pathology, Community Medicine, FMT, Radio Diagnosis, Skin & VD, Paediatrics, Dental, Orthopaedics, Medicine, Surgery, Anaesthesiology, Ophthalmology, O & G, ENT, Psychiatry etc. The aim is to ascertain the knowledge of the candidate as required for a General Duty Medical Officer
- 3. The list of eligible as well as ineligible candidates for the post of GDMO has been published on the website which may be checked by the candidates.**
4. Admit Cards for the examination for the post of GDMO have been sent by speed post to the eligible candidates on the basis of information/documents provided by the candidates in his/her application form. If any information/document is found false/incorrect his/her candidature will be cancelled instantly.
5. The candidates should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for the post of GDMO. Their candidature at all the stages of recruitment process will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If, on verification of document/information furnished by them, at any time before or after the written examination, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled.
6. Candidates may visit the office of the Delhi Cantonment Board, Sadar Bazar, Delhi Cantt and contact Establishment branch (Phone No. 011-25695450) for any problem regarding admit card or rejection of application on any working day prior to the date of examination. His/her valid request will be considered by the administration.

7. The candidates who had applied earlier and found eligible for the post of GDMO against the advertisement mentioned below will also get the admit cards by post only. If not received, they should contact the Office of the Cantonment Board during office hours i.e 0930 hrs to 1700 hrs, on any working day prior to the date of examination.
