Public Notice

No. DCB/32/SN-1/CoViD-19/2020

Dated: 6th Aug, 2020

1. It is notified for the information of public in general in Delhi Cantonment area that CoViD-19 suspected/ confirmed cases are home quarantine / isolated at home by the concerned Medical Authority. As per guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) & Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) specifically for the caretakers for CoViD-19 patient under **home-care shall follow the following Do's and Don'ts** for the collection and disposal of biomedical waste as well as waste generated from households of quarantine/ isolated houses:-

| DO's | DON'Ts |

| ➤ Care takers of CoViD-19 patients under home-care shall store the biomedical waste (used mask, gloves and tissues or swabs contaminated with blood/ body fluids of CoViD-19 patients, including used syringes medicines etc.) in two layered ' <u>Yellow coloured bag</u> ' (use two bags) provided by Delhi Cantonment Board and these bags be kept in dustbin. | ➤ Home-care taker shall never mix general waste with biomedical waste such as used mask, gloves and tissues or swabs contaminated with blood/ body fluids of CoViD-19 patients, including used syringes medicines etc. |
| ➤ Person taking care of suspected or confirmed (asymptomatic and mild symptomatic) CoViD-19 patient at home-care shall handover the yellow bag to authorized waste collector detailed by Delhi Cantonment Board or common biomedical waste treatment facility operator. | ➤ Never dispose off used masks of suspected or confirmed (mild symptomatic or asymptomatic) CoViD-19 patients in bags other than yellow bag. |
| ➤ General waste (solid waste) from home care or quarantine centre or quarantine camp shall be handed over to door to door waste collection vehicle in 'Black bag' to be provided by Delhi Cantonment Board. | ➤ Positive or suspected CoViD-19 patient shall never use fabric mask home-made masks, if any. ➤ Do not leave your used mask within the reach of others. ➤ Do not re-use surgical masks or gloves. |
| ➤ Masks and gloves used by persons not infected by CoViD-19 at quarantine homes or other households should be kept in paper bag for a minimum of 72 hours prior to disposal of the same as general waste. It is advisable to cut the masks prior to disposal to prevent reuse. | ➤ Quarantine centre or camp or homecare shall never store biomedical waste for more than 48 hrs. |
| ➤ Food grade paper packing type plate be used to serve the food to quarantine/ isolated CoViD-19 Patient. | ➤ Do not use disposable plastic plates/ Styrofoam plates (single use plastic) etc. to serve food to quarantine/ isolated CoViD-19 Patient. |
