### **Public Notice**

No. DCB/32/SN-1/CoViD-19/2020

Dated: 31 Aug, 2020

1. In continuation of Public Notice No. DCB/32/SN-1/CoViD-19/2020 dated 6<sup>th</sup> Aug 2020 issued in connection of waste management of quarantine/ isolated houses declared under CoViD-19.

2. It is notified for the appraisal of public in general residing in Delhi Cantonment area that quarantine/ isolated homes are declared under CoViD-19, such houses shall collect the waste in two forms separately i.e. Bio Medical Waste and General Waste. The composition of Biomedical waste and General waste has been revised and clarified by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) as per 4<sup>th</sup> Revision of Guidelines issued on 21.07.2020. Hence, in compliance of above the caretakers of CoViD-19 patient under **quarantine/ home-care shall adhere to the following composition of waste and its collection shall be ensured accordingly.**

#### **(a) Biomedical Covid-19 Waste :**

Biomedical waste generated from quarantine/ isolated houses under CoViD-19 comprises of used syringes, date expired or discarded medicines, used mask/gloves and in case of patient with other chronic disease may also include drain bags, urine bags, body or blood soaked tissues/ cotton, empty ampules etc. such Biomedical waste is to be collected in ‘Yellow Bags’ provided by Delhi Cantonment Board. The ‘Yellow Bag’ shall be handed over to Cantt Board Biomedical waste collection vehicle only.

#### **(b) General Solid Waste :**

General waste generated from quarantine/ isolated houses under CoViD-19 comprises of waste generated from kitchen, packaging material, waste food material, waste papers, waste plastics, floor cleaning dust, etc. including left-over food, disposable utensils, water bottles, tetra packs, used by suspected quarantined persons and COVID-19 patient such waste is to be collected in ‘Black Bags’ provided by Delhi Cantonment Board. The ‘Black Bag’ shall be handed over to Cantt Board Door to Door waste collection vehicle only.

3. Biomedical waste and general waste should be collected separately and shall never be mixed.

4. Rest of the contents of public notice issued by this office vide Public Notice No. DCB/32/SN-1/CoViD-19/2020 dated 6<sup>th</sup> Aug 2020 shall remain unchanged.

5. Violation of above may invite legal action against the violators.
